the crank up towers. The next day before operations began; I arrived in the afternoon and setup the solar panels to get a start charging the batteries. (This should probably have been done much earlier) Later in the early evening, I was able to make a couple of contacts using solar power. The experience has pointed out that I will need to improve the setup of both the solar array and the power distribution system. I split my operating time between 40 meters and 20 meters (about 3 hours in total) and managed to add a few contacts to the log in the process. I also spent about 3 hours acting as a logger and observing one of the better operators (and learning quite a bit in the process). Since this was the first "contest" (I'm more the rag-chew type) that I've been involved with, there clearly were a few gaps in my skills and a few things that I overlooked (like previous operator leaving the RIT offset by several KHz).

Did everything go perfectly: No. Were there things that we could improve: Absolutely. But overall, this was a great experience for me. If there is one thing that I was disappointed with, it was the low turn out. I'm referring to both the number of amateurs present and the complete lack of any public interest. This is something that we will need to work on for next year. Maybe a different location with more public traffic?
